Dan McLawhorn Former City Attorney - City of Raleigh, NC

Dan McLawhorn served as a distinguished member of the municipal clean water legal community and the NACWA Legal Affairs committee until his recent retirement as a City Attorney with the City of Raleigh, North Carolina.

Dan was an active member of the Legal Affairs Committee, participating regularly in meetings and telephone calls and always bringing insight and legal analysis to whatever the legal issue of the day was. He also served on a regular basis as part of the informal planning committee for NACWA's annual National Clean Water Law & Enforcement Seminar, helping identify topics that were timely and relevant for the seminar program. He also frequently served as a speaker and panelist at the seminar, sharing his legal acumen with his peers.

Dan was especially interested in issues around nutrient regulation in the water quality space.
